SECURITY: Preventing Identity Theft

Identity theft continues to be one of the fastest growing crimes in the United States. Community State Bank and the American Bankers Association recommends following these tips to keep your information – and your money – safe:

Passwords and PINs are Not for Sharing
Don't provide your Social Security number or account information to anyone who contacts you online or over the phone. Protect your PINs and passwords and do not share them with anyone. Use a combination of letters and numbers for your passwords and change them periodically. Do not reveal sensitive or personal information on social networking sites.

Keep an Eye Out for Missing Mail
Fraudsters look for monthly bank or credit card statements, or other mail containing your financial information. Consider enrolling in online banking to reduce the likelihood of paper statements being stolen. Also, consider using Bill Pay or automatic payments to help reduce the amount of payment information leaving your home.

Stay Up-to-Date on Your Accounts with Online Banking
Monitor your financial accounts regularly for fraudulent transactions. Sign up for bank app push notifications, text, or email alerts for certain types of transactions, such as online purchases or transactions of more than \$500.

Monitor Your Credit Report Regularly
Order a free copy of your credit report every twelve months from one of the three credit reporting agencies at annualcreditreport.com.
