This afternoon, we will arrive in Niagara Falls, New York! We will arrive at the amazing **Culinary Institute** for an included lunch. Next, we will visit the **Observation Tower** and soak in the beauty of all three waterfalls – the Horseshoe, American and Bridal Veil Falls. Day 3 B, D

Today, a local guide joins us for the day as we embard on a scenic narrated cruise while you soak up the city's engineering marvel while being raised and lowered 50 feet in Locks 34 & 35, the only double set on the erie Canal. **Experience "Life in the Past Lane**" when you get on board for your cruise on the historic Erie Canal, a 363-mile waterway between the Hudson River with Niagara River and the Great Lakes and an important part of American history. **past five of the original 1800's locks.** Head to the **Challenger Learning Center of Lockport**, and become an astronaut for an afternoon with a space mission simulator, planetarium shows, and more. Next **visit the oldest continuously occupied military site** in North America. Tour original 18th century buildings, witness musket and artillery demonstrations, and take part in living history programs. Tour the historic grounds that include 18th-century fortifications in several original buildings. You'll also learn what daily life was like for the men and women that lived in service at the Fort through exciting, living history programs given by our knowledgeable, historic interpretation staff. Dinner is included overlooking the Falls.

Day 4 B, D

Today we make our way to the Big Apple, New York City. We will meet our local guide and take a **backstage tour of Radio City Music Hall**. Learn about this historical famous music hall and meet a Rockette (photos allowed). Next, stop is **St. Patrick's Cathedral** where you will spend a little time taking in all the beauty. Check-into your hotel located right in the Theatre District and enjoy a fun **New York City Dinner Theatre** experience. **Day 5 B**, **D**

Today, we will take the **Ferry to visit the Statue of Liberty and Ellis Island**. At Ellis Island, learn about our country's history at the Immigration Museum.
